In this Actuvirtual Symposium we attend to Dr Shobana Shankar's book, *An Uneasy Embrace: Africa, India and the Spectre of Race* and engage the history and the controversial question of how Africans and Indians make and unmake their differences. Drawing on archival and oral sources from seven countries, *An Uneasy Embrace* traces how economic tensions surrounding the Indian diaspora in East and Southern Africa collide with widening Indian networks in West Africa and the Black Atlantic, forcing a racial reckoning over the course of the twentieth century.
